

CONSENT TO THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA OF INDIVIDUAL USERS

By submitting a request on the websites cfn.su and pinkamena.com, the User gives their consent to CFN LLC (legal address: 108834, Moscow, inner territory of the city Kommunarka municipal district, Kommunarka settlement, Potapovskaya Roshcha Street, 18, Bldg. 2, Room 1P), represented by the Manager – individual entrepreneur Maria Igorevna Vershinina (hereinafter referred to as the Operator), to process their personal data voluntarily, of their own free will, and in their own interests, and confirming their legal capacity, under the following conditions:

1. This Consent is given for the processing of personal data, i.e., the performance of, among other things, the following actions: processing (including collection, systematization, accumulation, storage, clarification) (updating, modification), use, depersonalization, blocking, and destruction of personal data), while a general description of the above data processing methods is provided in Federal Law No. 152 of July 27, 2006, as well as the transfer of such information to third parties, in cases established by regulatory documents of higher authorities and legislation, both without the use of automation and with their use.

2. Consent is given to the processing of the following personal data, which is not special or biometric:

- last name, first name, patronymic;
- contact telephone number;
- email address.

3. Personal data is not publicly available.

4. Purpose of personal data processing:

- processing incoming requests from individuals for the purpose of providing feedback;
- providing access to the personal account on the websites cfn.su and pinkamena.com;
- ensuring the ability to restore access to your personal account on the websites cfn.su and pinkamena.com

5. The basis for processing personal data is:

Article 24 of the Constitution of the Russian Federation;

Article 6 of Federal Law No. 152-FL "On Personal Data";

This Consent to the Processing of Personal Data.

6. Processed personal data will be destroyed upon achieving the processing purposes or when the need for achieving these purposes is no longer necessary, unless otherwise provided by federal law.

Furthermore, the processing of personal data may be terminated at the request of the personal data subject.

7. Consent may be revoked by the personal data subject or their representative by sending a written request to the Operator by email at info@cfn.su.

8. This consent is valid until the processing of the personal data specified in paragraphs 6 and 7 of this Consent is terminated.
